One of the largest natural amphitheatres in the world, the Hollywood Bowl seats just under 18,000 people. The Hollywood Bowl is a County Park and is jointly operated by the Los Angeles Philharmonic and the Department of Parks and Recreation. Since its opening in 1922, the Hollywood Bowl has been the summer home to the Los Angeles Philharmonic. The Hollywood Bowl is also the home to the Hollywood Bowl Orchestra.
